They may write about challenging events in their lives that relate to a book they have read. The possibilities are limitless.

There are three categories of competition: grades 4-6, grades 7-8 and grades 9-12. The contest is open to all Texas students, including public, private and home school.

First-place winners receive \$300. Second-place winners receive \$200, and third-place winners receive \$100. Winning students will be recognized and receive their awards at the Texas Library Association Annual Conference in Houston, in March 2026.
