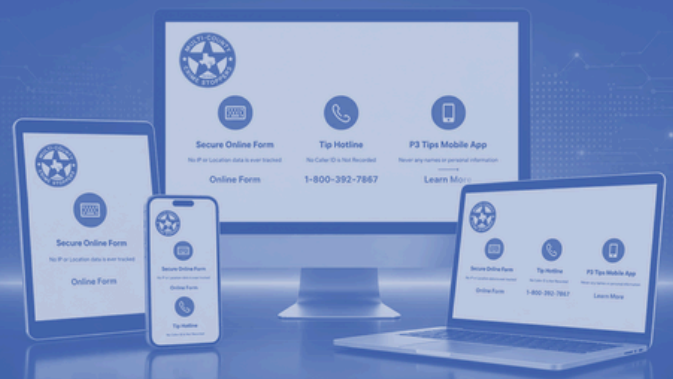

ABOUT MCCS

Multi-County Crime Stoppers (MCCS) is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization led by a volunteer civilian board serving Montgomery, Liberty, and San Jacinto counties. We operate a 24-hour tip line, answered 365 days a year, allowing citizens who wish to remain anonymous to share information that may assist local law enforcement agencies in investigating felony crimes and locating wanted fugitives.

We work with the public, news media, and law enforcement agencies to publicize and gather information on felony crimes occurring in our tri-county area and to assist in the apprehension of wanted fugitive felons.

OUR HISTORY

Since July 6, 1981, Crime Stoppers has served Montgomery County with a commitment to strengthening public safety through community involvement and anonymous reporting. As the organization continued to grow, state certification on October 10, 2014 expanded services into Liberty and San Jacinto counties, bringing Multi-County Crime Stoppers support and resources to communities that had gone without local Crime Stoppers support for many years.

Over more than four decades, what began as a local program serving one county has evolved into a regional effort supporting communities across Montgomery, Liberty, and San Jacinto counties. While our reach has expanded, our purpose remains unchanged: providing citizens with a trusted and anonymous way to share information that helps strengthen public safety and create safer communities.

Multi-County Crime Stoppers serves a diverse region spanning Montgomery, Liberty, and San Jacinto counties. From rapidly growing suburban communities to rural areas covering nearly 3,000 square miles, we help connect citizens with law enforcement through anonymous reporting and community partnerships.

Together, these communities represent nearly 900,000 residents across 2,828 square miles of Southeast Texas.

SERVING OUR COMMUNITIES

Supporting Law Enforcement During San Jacinto County Manhunt

MCCS was the first organization to offer a reward for information during the manhunt that followed the mass shooting near Cleveland, Texas. What began with a \$5,000 MCCS reward later grew to a combined \$80,000 reward offer involving local, state, and federal partners.

Cold Case Warm-Up Initiative

MCCS partnered with the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office and Clear Channel Outdoor to help launch the Cold Case Warm-Up Initiative. Featured cold case information was displayed across Clear Channel Outdoor's digital billboard network to generate leads and encourage anonymous tip reporting. MCCS also offered rewards of up to \$5,000 for information leading to the resolution of featured cases.

Featured Felons

Each week, MCCS distributes its Featured Felons bulletin through a broad network of law enforcement agencies, media outlets, social media platforms, and community partners, increasing public awareness of wanted fugitives and encouraging anonymous tips that may assist law enforcement in locating them.

Community Outreach & Public Awareness

Educational materials, outreach campaigns, public awareness initiatives, and crime prevention programs help encourage anonymous reporting and strengthen community engagement.

Safe School Program

MCCS partners with schools and community organizations to improve campus safety through its Safe School Program, including fundraising efforts to provide Bearcade® classroom door barricades and support other school safety initiatives throughout the tri-county region.

Charlotte Branham Memorial Scholarship

Established in honor of longtime Board member Charlotte Branham, the scholarship program supports the children of law enforcement employees and students pursuing careers in law enforcement throughout Montgomery, Liberty, and San Jacinto counties.

Supporting Law Enforcement Initiatives

MCCS has invested in specialized equipment and technology that supports law enforcement and enhances public safety. Examples include:

- Ballistic vests to help protect K-9 officers during law enforcement operations.
- Thermal imaging drone used to assist in searches for missing persons and suspects.
- Sonar equipment supporting underwater search and recovery efforts.
- LiveScan fingerprint equipment to enhance law enforcement identification capabilities.

HOW IT WORKS



For Example Purposes Only

Report Anonymously—Anytime. Anywhere. 24/7/365

- Someone knows something about a felony crime or a wanted fugitive.
- They contact MCCS to submit an anonymous tip.
No IP Tracking, No Location Tracking, No Caller ID & Calls Not Recorded
- A Tip ID code is provided. **Save it**—it is required to check a tip status and cannot be retrieved if lost.
- The tip information is forwarded to the law enforcement agency responsible for the investigation.
- If the tip leads to a felony arrest or the recovery of stolen property or narcotics, the tipster may be eligible for a cash reward.

HOW TO SUBMIT TIPS

Phone

Call the tip hotline at 1-800-392-7867 to report criminal activity. You are not required to provide your name, and your identity remains protected throughout the process.

Mobile App

Download the free P3 Tips app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store to securely submit anonymous tips from mobile devices.
