Heng was one of more than 1,600 students who graduated in the summer and received an undergraduate, master's or doctoral degree. Many summer graduates joined the university-wide

commencement ceremonies in May, marking the occasion with the broader UT Austin community.

During the 2024-2025 academic year, which ended in August, UT conferred a record 16,036 degrees. The record is attributed to the University's all-time highs for first-year student retention and four-year graduation rates.
