Liberty County include: • Hull-Daisetta Rotary Club Collection (at Sam Houston Center) - The Hull-Daisetta Rotary Club was chartered on April 1, 1926, in Hull, Liberty County, Texas. In 2006, several local individuals and organizations began working to support renovation of the Hull-Daisetta Rotary Club building and preserve its legacy. It was moved to the grounds of the Sam Houston Regional Library and Research Center in June 2010 and now

houses an exhibit on the heritage of Rotary clubs and community service in Southeast Texas. The Hull-Daisetta Rotary Club documents collection some of the activities of the club, with records including attendance and program records, membership rosters, correspondence, financial records, newsletters, photographs, posters, and artifacts. Materials date 1926-1979, 2010, bulk 1949-1979.
