Josephine's Catfish Stew

Take as much big chunks of catfish – it has to be from a big catfish – firm meat – and cut it in chunks – as you need for the purpose. Salt, pepper and set aside. Put about 2 inches of water into a large heavy pot with a lid to it and throw in about 10 chopped cloves of garlic, large cloves. Add 3 or 4 (or more if desired) pods of bird-eye peppers. Boil until the garlic is cooked soft and then thicken with a little flour and cook 5 minutes more until the flour is done. Lay the fish carefully into this garlic-pepper broth, over and poach gently for just a few minutes. Don't overcook. Eat with thin cornbread cooked in an iron skillet. It should be crisp.
