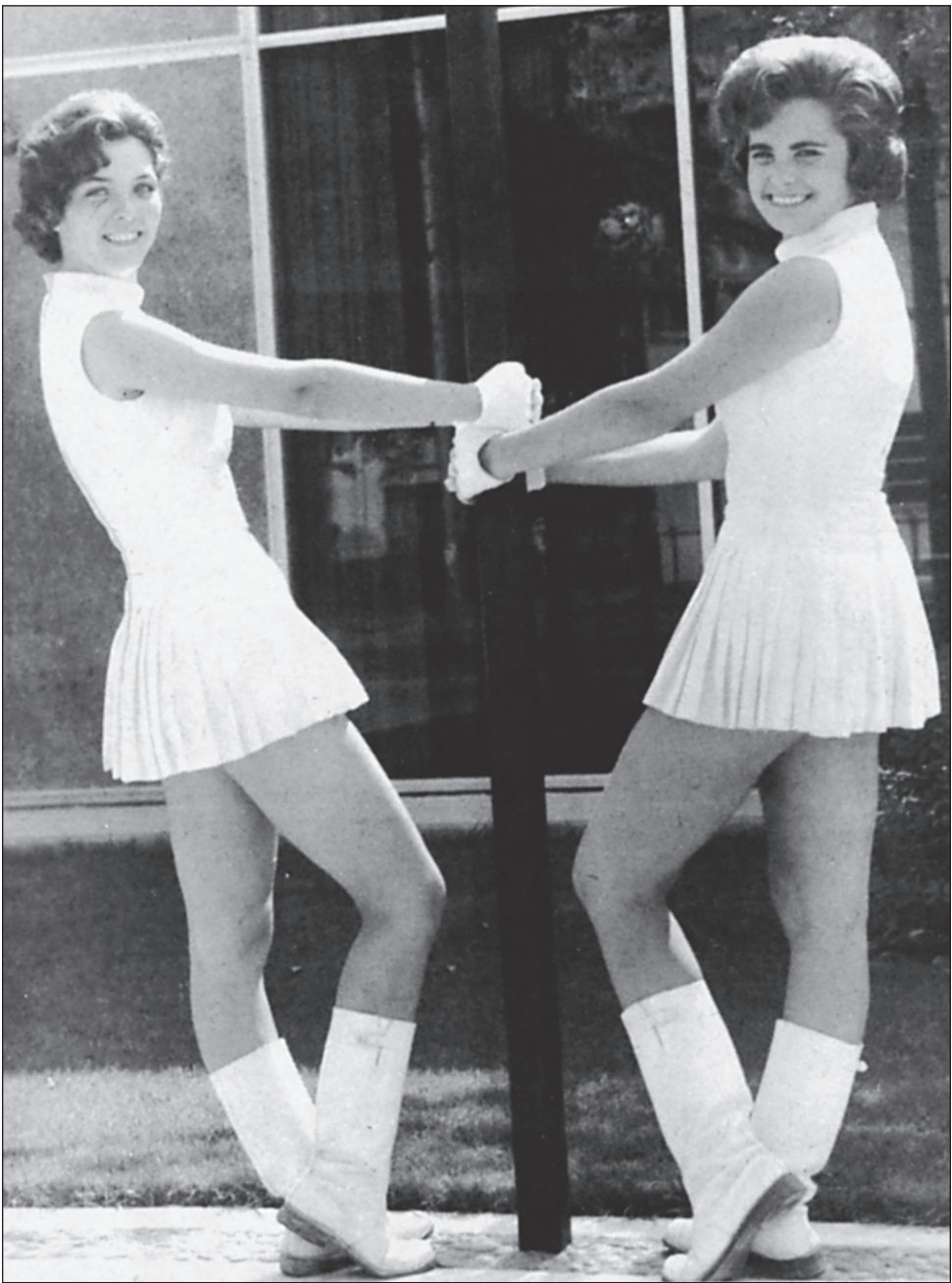


# HISTORY & FOLKLORE
