

Dayton VFD Memorial Golf Tournament coming up Sept. 12

DAYTON - Several years ago, members of the Dayton Volunteer Fire Department began planning a golf tournament fundraiser; however, due to inclement weather, the event was unfortunately unable to take place. This year, members have once again come together to plan and schedule the tournament to finally make it happen.

In honor of the 343 firefighters who lost their lives on September 11, 2001, this years event will be called the DVFD/343 Memorial Golf Tournament. The tournament serves to honor the bravery and sacrifice of those fallen heroes.

The tournament will be held September 12, at Liberty Municipal Golf Course and will feature a four-man

scramble format with a \$500 per team entry fee. Each player will receive three drink tickets, a goodie bag, breakfast and lunch. Players will tee off at 7 a.m.

Driving Range (\$500): Allows golfers to warm up before their round. Yard sign at driving range. Can set up a tent and pass out items. Interact with all participants (network).

Beverage Sponsor (\$500): Provides all beverages to golfers throughout the day. Each golfer is given 5 drink tickets. Yard sign near entrance of the restaurant. Can set up a tent and interact with participants (network).

Breakfast Sponsor (\$500): Provides breakfast for all AM participants. Yard sign near entrance of the restaurant. Can set up a tent and interact with partic-

ipants (network).

Lunch Sponsor (\$2,000): Provides lunch for all participants. Yard sign near entrance of restaurant. Can set up tent and interact with all participants (network). Sponsor highlight on DVFD Facebook page.

All proceeds from the tournament will directly benefit the Dayton VFD by helping fund truck maintenance, tool purchases and upkeep, and PPE (personal protective equipment) purchases and maintenance.
