Notice of Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option

FM 787 Trinity River Bridge Replacement
From 0.75 miles North of CR 2164A in Rayburn, TX to CR 2151 in Romayor, TX
CSJ: 0813-01-110, Liberty County, Texas

Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Beaumont District is proposing to reconstruct the Trinity River Bridge on FM 787 connecting Romayor and Rayburn in Liberty County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an online virtual public meeting on the proposed project with an in-person option. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by Wednesday, July 1, 2026, at 5 p.m. and will remain online for at least 15 days.** To view the virtual public meeting, go to the following web address at the date and time indicated above: txdot.gov, keyword search "FM 787 Trinity River". If you do not have internet access, you may call (409) 898-5732 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing an in-person option for individuals who would like to participate in person instead of online. The in-person option will be held in an open house format. In-person attendees will be able to view the same presentation delivered in the online public meeting which will be playing on a screen, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff and consultants, and leave written comments. **The in-person option will be held on Wednesday, July 1, 2026, from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. at The Retreat at Artesian Lakes Conference Center, located at 235 Chain-O-Lakes Resort Cleveland, TX 77327.**

Proposed improvements include reconstructing and realigning the FM 787 Trinity River Bridge at a new location between Rayburn and Romayor. The proposed alignment would be approximately 2 miles in length with a proposed right of way of 150 feet. The proposed pavement would have two travel lanes, one in each direction, with shoulders on each side.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling (409) 828-7284.

The proposed project would involve construction in wetlands. The proposed project would involve an action in a floodplain.

Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Beaumont District, located at 8350 Eastex Freeway, Beaumont, TX 77708-1701, or via phone at (409) 892-7311. Project materials are also available online at txdot.gov, keyword search "FM 787 Trinity River". These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person option.

The virtual public meeting and in-person option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person option, please contact Tanya Avila, Public Information Officer (PIO), TxDOT Beaumont District, at (409) 898-5745, no later than 4 p.m. CT, Friday, June 26, 2026. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.

Ed Seymour presented the first-ever Pat Seymour Memorial Scholarship in memory of his dear wife Pat, who was a teacher and Libertad member. The \$1,000 scholarship was presented to Jocelyn Perez, a 2026 graduate of Liberty High School.

The 2026-2028 slate of Libertad DAR officers was installed with one member unable to attend. The new slate of officers is Ann Daniel Rogers, regent; Dani Daniel Brister, vice regent; Catherine Rogers Kuchan, secretary; Susan Daniel, treasurer; and Myrna Finch, registrar.

The program was on the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. "Known But To God," are the words carved into the marble of the tomb. Regent Ann Rogers enlightened members by combining a video documentary with her own research into the intense discipline, secrets, and strict daily routines required to guard this sacred site at Arlington National Cemetery. It included how everything re-

volves around the number "21", from mirroring the 21-gun salute to the 21 steps the sentinel takes and more. It takes an average of eight hours of preparation just to get a single uniform ready for a two-hour shift. Soldiers have guarded the tomb in the rain, sleet, snow or historic blizzards - 24 hours a day, 365 days a year since 1937.
