Liberty PD officer indicted by grand jury

LIBERTY - Jason Grindstaff, a former Liberty Police Department officer, turned himself in to authorities on the morning of July 3, stemming from a Grand Jury indictment last month.

On December 3, 2025, City of Liberty Police Chief Richard Ashe was notified of a complaint involving Officer Grindstaff. That same day, the Texas Rangers initiated an investigation and requested an interview with the officer. Immediately following that interview, the officer was sent home pending further review.

On December 4, 2025, Chief Ashe placed Officer Grindstaff on administrative leave. Throughout the investigation, the Liberty Police Department cooperated fully with the Texas Rangers and provided requested records, documents, and other materials to assist with their in-

vestigation.

Officer Grindstaff resigned from employment with the City of Liberty on February 27, 2026, while still on administrative leave.

Consistent with city policy and accepted best practices, the City of Liberty does not comment on the details of ongoing criminal investigations or pending legal proceedings. This practice helps preserve the integrity of the investigative and judicial processes and ensure that all parties receive fair consideration under the law.

The City of Liberty remains committed to maintaining public trust, accountability and professionalism in all municipal operations. Any additional questions regarding the criminal case should be directed to the appropriate prosecutorial or law enforcement authorities.
