

LCSO checks out
threats to schools
in Colony Ridge

On the evening of February 10, 2026, the Liberty County Sheriff's Office was made aware of a potential threat directed toward charter schools located in the Colony Ridge subdivision in Cleveland.

Upon receiving this information, the Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigation Division immediately initiated an investigation. With assistance from the Texas Department of Public Safety, investigators were able to quickly identify the source of the reported threats and respond accordingly.

Following a thorough investigation, it was determined that the threats were unfounded and posed no danger to the schools, staff, or students.

The Liberty County Sheriff's Office will be seeking criminal charges against the individual or individuals responsible for creating and disseminating the videos across the internet.

The Sheriff's Office takes all threats toward our schools seriously and remains committed to ensuring the safety of our students and educators.
