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ADVERTISEMENT AND INVITATION FOR BIDS

The City of Kenefick will receive bids for the CITY OF KENEFICK, TEXAS 2021 CDBG CONTRACT NO. CDV21-0226 STREET IMPROVEMENTS until 10:00 AM on Thursday, May 16th, 2024 at the City of Kenefick City Hall, 228 FM 2797 Dayton, TX 77535. The Bids will be publicly opened at this location and read aloud immediately following. Bids are invited for several items and quantity of work as follows,

- 1. River Boat Bend (Base Bid): Reconstruct approximately two thousand one hundred linear feet (2,100 LF) of street including sub-grade reconstruction, HMAC surfacing, and all associated appurtenances.
- 2. River Boat Bend (Additive Bid No. 1): Reconstruct approximately five hundred linear feet (500 LF) of street including sub-grade reconstruction, HMAC surfacing, and all associated appurtenances.
- 3. Martha Lane (Additive Bid No. 2): Reconstruct approximately one thousand two hundred linear feet (1,200 LF) of HMAC pavement, including eighty-eight linear feet (88 LF) of culverts, eight hundred and thirty-one linear feet (831 LF) of drainage reconstruction, and all associated appurtenances.
- 4. Soft Subgrade Remediation (Additive Bid No. 3): Repair weak areas in the subgrade layer found by proof rolling activities (maximum of 44CY for River Boat Bend and 17CY for Martha Lane) by chemical treatment of the existing soils.

A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Kenefick or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (at par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

Funding for this project is covered under Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968. All eligible bidders must comply with Section 3 requirement in regard to meeting or exceeding the required objectives for both hiring and subcontracting. In accordance with these objectives, contractors are required to direct their newly created employment and/or subcontracting opportunities to Section 3 Residents and Business Concerns

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the federally determined prevailing (Davis-Bacon and Related Acts) wage rate, as issued by the Texas Department of Agriculture Office of Rural Affairs and contained in the contract documents, must be paid on this project. In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, sexual identity, gender identity, or national origin.

Any contract or contracts awarded under this Invitation for Bids are expected to be funded by CDBG Contract CDV21-0226.

No Pre-Bid Conference will be held on this project. All questions shall be received through CIVCAST or in writing via email until Friday, May 10th, 2024, at 5:00PM and addressed by Addendum.

The City of Kenefick reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. Bids may be held by City of Kenefick for a period not to exceed 60 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.
